
Men's Rules



You can play with 9 (but must take an automatic out)

You can bat 11

You can re-enter 2 players but they must bat in the same spot.

3 courtesy runners (only 1 per inning)

20 after 3

15 after 4

12 after 5

10 after 6

No inning can start after 7:10

Or 8:20

Captains of the winning team must e-mail or text score 24 hours after the game.

If there are an even number of teams – please alternate home team each time you play.

8 team divisions coin flip gets home team.

Remember a forced runner must give himself up at the base.

Defensive players cannot lineup for a throw in the base paths.

If a runner collides with a defensive player they are out and a dead ball is called. The runner **may be** ejected per umpires ruling.

Third strike foul batter is out

there is a strict no argument rule between umpires and players

I player may question a call at the time of the play. After the next play starts If a plyer continues to argue they can be ejected by the Umpire

If a player is ejected they must leave the ballpark. – 2 minutes

After the game under no circumstance should a player approach an umpire and argue a call. The player will be suspended until a hearing is called.

If a team thinks the other team is using an illegal bat they must ask the umpire to check it.

Any protest must be filed at the time of the infraction

The ump must sign the book.

All other rules must follow standard ASA rules.
